Rob Rossi from C.S. McKee discussed factors affecting the Potter County Employees Retirement Fund and detailed its performance during the third quarter of 2023. At the end of the quarter, the fund's value was \$18,296,891 up from \$18,966,384 at the end of the second quarter of 2023. By category:

- Large-Cap Core Equity return was -3.17% for the quarter
- Small-Cap Core Equity return was -4.95%
- Small-Cap Passive Equity return was -4.99%
- International Mutual Fund returned -4.61%
- Fixed Income return was -1.96%
- Total portfolio returned -2.85%
