Shane Nickolick with C.S. McKee presented a synopsis of economic conditions during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2022. He led by stating that multiple factors negatively affected the markets in 2022. However, the fourth-quarter results of the Potter County Employees' Retirement Fund were more encouraging. Economists now forecast a mild recession in 2023. Mike Donnally, also from C.S. McKee, discuss shifts made in allocations of the counties assets between stocks and bonds and noted that the firm has adopted a conservative approach due to market volatility. At the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter, the fund's value was \$17,579,043, up from \$16,717,159 at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2022. By category:

- Large-Cap Core Equity return was 7.82% for the quarter
- Small-Cap Core Equity return was 6.44% quarter
- Small-Cap Passive Equity return was 6.70% for the quarter
- International Mutual Fund returned 17.31% for the quarter
- Fixed Income had a gain of 1.86% for the quarter
- Total portfolio returned 6.14% for the quarter
