COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS

Comm. Kefover reported that she attended a Senior Corps Experience Works luncheon and appreciates the efforts that all of them do to support community essential programs and organizations. Comm. Kefover also reported on a CCAP Community and Economic Development Committee Conference call. Currently a concern is that anyone that is laid off cannot participate in a class or seminar to start their own business while receiving unemployment compensation.

Comm. Heimel reported on legislation being considered by the Pa. General Assembly to allow local governments to eliminate the real estate tax. He said that option would increase the tax burden of county residents, since absentee property owners would have their local taxes eliminated.

Comm. Heimel introduced Potter County Criminal Justice Resource Coordinator Jessica Giebel, who will be collecting data related to criminal justice expenses; advising the commissioners on expenses and outcomes; and serving as a liaison with the court system for the commissioners, who are responsible for the funding, facilities and most of the personnel engaged in the criminal justice system. Ms. Giebel said her first priorities are to familiarize herself with the county's system, establish contact with statewide and national peers in the field, and assist the county to implement the national Data-Driven Justice Initiative, which is a priority adopted by the Potter County Criminal Justice Advisory Board. Comm. Morley added that the new position fills a gap that has existed for some time and will provide the commissioners with the data and tools to more effectively manage the county's limited resources.
