

**Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters  
County of Potter**

**2020 General Election (November 3, 2020)**

This is an official notice of a Primary election to be conducted on November 3, 2020 in Potter County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com) or [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov). You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to 814-274-7395 or by email to [slewis@pottercountypa.net](mailto:slewis@pottercountypa.net)

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for a candidate for President of the United States and U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress) as well as candidates for all state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for President of the United States and U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress), write in the name of the candidate of your choice in the space provided on the FWAB.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of the candidates or ballot initiative in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum questions write "yes" or "no".

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES – Vote for One – All precincts within Potter County

ATTORNEY GENERAL – Vote for One – All precincts within Potter County

AUDITOR GENERAL – Vote for One – All precincts within Potter County

STATE TREASURER – Vote for One – All precincts within Potter County

REPRESENTATIVE IN CONGRESS – 12<sup>th</sup> Congressional District – Vote for One – All precincts within Potter County

SENATOR IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 25<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District – Vote for One – All precincts within Potter County

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 67<sup>th</sup> Legislative District – Vote for One  
(All precincts within Potter County EXCEPT for Galeton Wards 1 & 2, & Pike Township)

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 68<sup>th</sup> Legislative District – Vote for One  
(Galeton Wards 1 & 2, & Pike Township ONLY)
